SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR PERNOD RICARD USA, LLC HEALTH AND WELFARE BENEFITS PLAN

This is a summary of the annual report of the Pernod Ricard USA, LLC Health and Welfare Benefits Plan (Employer Identification Number 52-2318616, Plan Number 501) for the plan year 01/01/2020 through 12/31/2020. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Pernod Ricard USA, LLC has committed itself to pay certain dental and temporary disability claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

Insurance Information

The plan has insurance contracts with Federal Insurance Company, Kaiser Foundation Health Plan Inc., Vision Service Plan, Aetna Life Insurance Co. and Hartford Life and Accident to pay certain accidental death and dismemberment, health, vision, life insurance, and long-term disability claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending 12/31/2020 were \$2,110,484.

Because they are so called "experience-rated" contracts, the premium costs are affected by, among other things, the number and size of claims. Of the total insurance premiums paid for the plan year ending 12/31/2020, the premiums paid under such "experience-rated" contracts were \$13,381 and the total of all benefit claims paid under these experience-rated contracts during the plan year was \$24,810.
